### FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

**JUNE 12, 2019**

Today, June 12, 2019, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of North Dakota triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from Flooding that occurred March 21 to April 28, 2019. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Public Assistance (PA):	(Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):
PA-Designated Counties:	Adams, Barnes, Cass, Dickey, Emmons, Grand Forks, Grant, Hettinger, LaMoure, Logan, McKenzie, Morton, Pembina, Ransom, Richland, Sargent, Steele, Traill, and Walsh Counties.
Hazard Mitigation (HM):	(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):
HM-Designated Areas:	All areas in the State of North Dakota are eligible for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
OTHER:	Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
